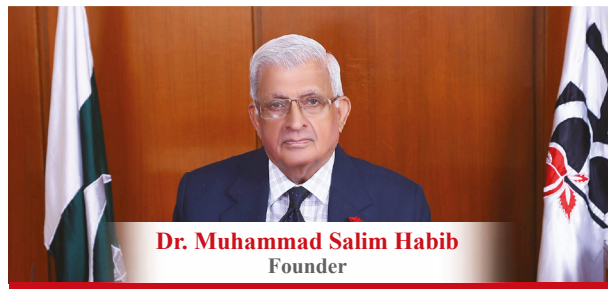

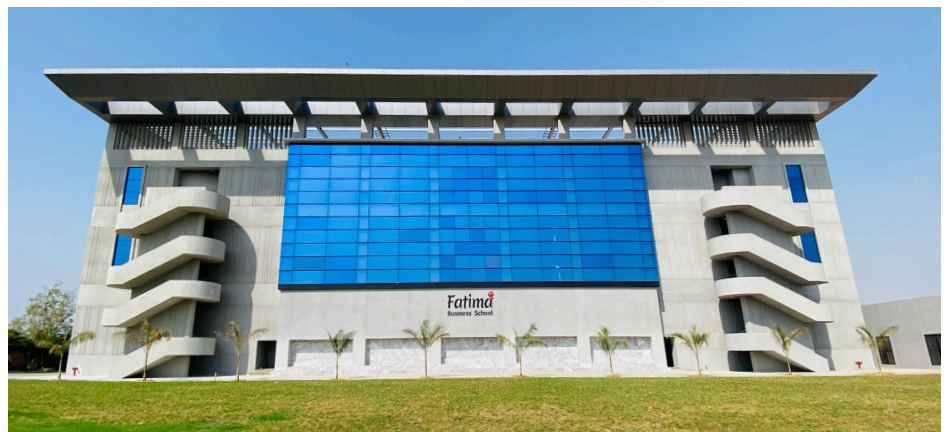

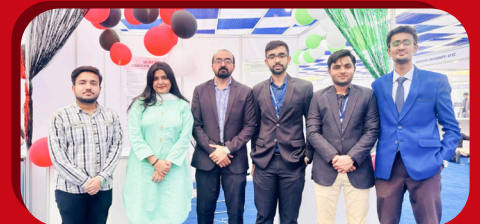


Pharmacy Students Exhibit Research at 8th DICE DUHS
