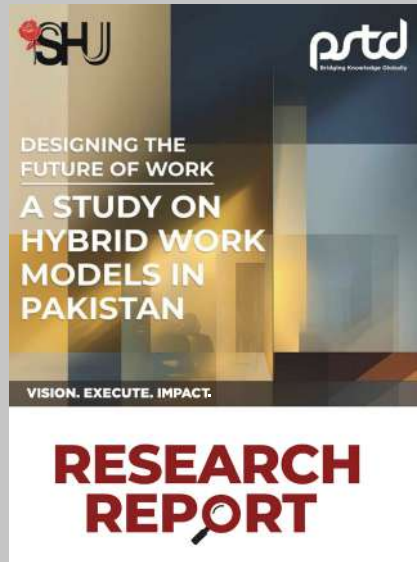

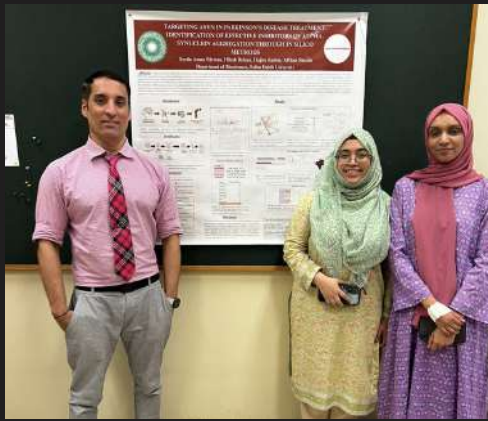

Write Right: Navigating Plagiarism & AI Reports with Turnitin

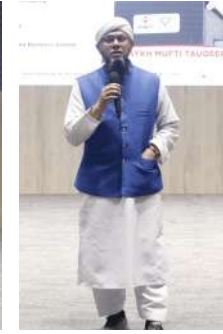
